The text-to-speech tool can be accessed by clicking on the **audio** button. In the Academic Skills modules, this button appears in the top right of the screen. In **Digital Skills** and **Soft Skills**, this button appears in the bottom right of the screen. Students can turn off the audio by clicking the button a second time.

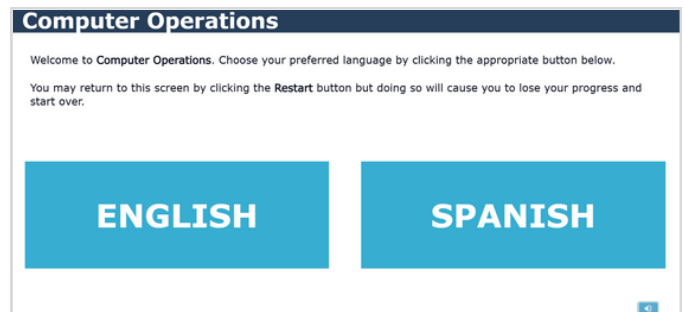


Language Preference

Screen Reader Functionality

All images in the courseware modules are tagged with descriptive Alt Text for students using screen-readers.

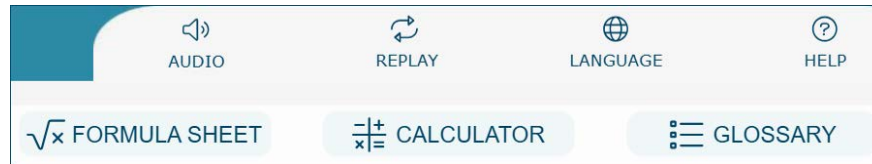
The accessibility text for each question includes instructions for how to select an answer, submit, and continue, to assist students using screen-readers.

Navigation buttons in the courseware are set to an intuitive tab order to enable students with screen-readers to navigate using their computer keyboard.



Module-specific Accessibility Features

In the Work Ready Math courseware, students can access a calculator, formula sheet and a key words document by clicking the corresponding buttons at the top of the screen.



In the Soft Skills courseware, instructional videos are used throughout the modules. Students can access written transcripts of these videos by clicking the **Transcript** button.
