




## WIN Learning Chromebook LockDown Browser

ChromeOS Minimum Version: 138


### Installing the WIN Learning Chromebook extension on Managed Chromebooks

The following instructions describe how to install the WIN Learning LockDown Browser on managed Chromebooks using Chrome Device Management.

1. Login to the Google Admin Suite at <https://admin.google.com>
2. Select **Devices > Chrome > Apps & extensions** on the left side of the page.
  - a. The Overview Page opens.
3. Select **Users and browsers** along the top.
4. Hover over the yellow circle with the + sign and then select “Add Chrome app or extension by ID”



5. Enter the WIN Learning LockDown Browser extension ID:  
hlefggefepngclaemmldobjidbaeocck



- a. Click Save
6. Change the Installation Policy for the extension to "Force Install"
- a. Click Save on the top right side of the screen.
7. Verify that the lockdown browser was successfully installed on the Chromebooks using the **Manage Extensions** feature in Chrome.

The following instructions describe how to install the WIN Learning LockDown Browser on a Chromebook that is not managed.


## Testing the Lockdown Browser

1. Login to the Chromebook and open a browser
  - a. If testing managed Chromebooks the account must be in the same OU the extension is installed in
2. Navigate to: <https://assessments.wincrsystem.com/LockedBrowser/Test>
3. Click the "Open Locked Browser" link on the Locked Browser Test Page
4. If the Locked Browser extension is installed properly a page will load that says "SUCCESS! This page loaded in the locked browser successfully"

## The Student Experience

Students will login to their Chromebook normally, open the Chrome browser, and navigate to [mi.wincrsystem.com](https://mi.wincrsystem.com).

After logging in at [mi.wincrsystem.com](https://mi.wincrsystem.com) the student will navigate to the landing page for their assessment and click the appropriate button to launch the assessment. When the student opens the assessment they will see a screen indicating that the LockDown Browser is opening



And finally, a page with a button to start their assessment.
